*To continue to develop an understanding of Phase 2, set one and two sounds. (s/a/t/p/i/n/m/d/g/o/c and k/ck/e/u) *Some children will be working on set three and four. (r/h/b/f and I / II / ff / ss) *To review sounds learned. *To use our knowledge of sounds to begin to blend some words. *Some children will be developing a recognition of Phase 2 tricky words.	*To continue to have a daily guided reading session. *Some children are beginning to blend words within their guided reading session. *To develop our comprehension skills, using the pictures inside the book to help us answer questions. *To look at different focus books throughout the half term relating to our topic of seeds, soil and sunshine. *To develop our attention skills to listen to stories as part of a group and begin to join in with repeated parts of the story.	*To have daily handwriting sessions focusing on letter formations. *To make purposeful marks on paper using a range of materials and to begin to ascribe meaning to those marks. *To recognise our own name and begin to make marks to represent writing our name. *Some children will identify initial sounds and segment words to help us label pictures with CVC words. *To colour in pictures and remain inside of the lines. *To take part in Mat Man sessions.	*To recall a sequence of events in everyday life and stories. *To sequences times of the day. *To continue to develop counting skills up to 20 through daily counting sessions, maths stories and counting songs. *To use mathematical vocabulary relating to time. *To begin to explore capacity by filling containers with water and soil. *To explore differences in height, weight and length.	*To plant seeds and care for growing plants. *To begin to show care and concern for living things in the environment. *To observe changes in plants as they grow. *To understand that plants need water and sunshine.	*To identify changes from being a baby to now. *Identify baby, child, adult. *To engage in role play activities with babies such as rocking, feeding, bathing, dressing. *To begin to understand the concept of boys and girls. *To accept turn taking with adult support and encouragement.
